


Installing Spellex Write-Assist for Chrome


To install Spellex-Assist for Chrome you must add it from the Google Web Store. Open your Chrome browser and navigate to the <u>Google Web Store</u>. Search for Spellex Write-Assist for Chrome and select the appropriate entry or <u>click this link</u>. Once the extension page is open, an "Add to Chrome" button should display in blue. Click to add the Spellex extension to your Chrome browser.

Create a profile


Once the setup process finishes, a Spellex icon will appear in your Chrome browser:



Click the Spellex icon to create your user profile by clicking the **Sign Up** link:




Enter the information requested to create your profile. Click **SIGN UP** when done.






You will receive an email message with a confirmation sign-up code to activate your account.

Spellex Write-Assist for Chrome Features

Spelling and Grammar

Adds advanced *Spell Check As You Type* across the web. The extension is packed with robust terminology necessary in higher education and beyond. It includes Comprehensive English, Medical, Legal, Bioscience, and Veterinary vocabularies to cover all levels. Additionally, grammar support is included.

To use: Once activated, Spellex will automatically check text for spelling and grammar errors. A red underline will indicate if the word is misspelled or has a grammatical error. Click on the term in question to view and select suggestions.



Spell Check Reporting

Generate spell check reports to identify common spelling errors. The report will provide context and focus individuals on their spelling errors to help improve spelling comprehension.

To use: Click on the Spelling icon in the toolbar and then click on the + icon. A pdf file will be created displaying any spelling errors while using the Spellex tollbar.



Word Prediction

Adds predictive text options to help improve writing comprehension and efficiency.



To use: Once activated, Word Prediction suggestions will automatically be presented as you type as long as the field is compatible with the feature. Click on any suggestion to complete the word.



Text-to-Speech

Have selected text read back to you in a human-like voice. Users can select from a list of different voices as well as the speed the text is read. Spellex offers the option to download the selected text as an .mp3 file to listen to while offline or on the go.

To use: Highlight any text and click the Text-to-Speech option in the toolbar. A play menu will appear where speed and type of voice can be selected. Press the play icon to have the text read back to you. To save the text as audio, simply press the download button after clicking on the Text-to-Speech icon in the toolbar.



Speech-to-Text

Dictate your voice into text in any compatible text areas or fields. The voice recognition feature is enhanced with Spellex's specialized vocabularies to support complex fields of study such as medicine, law, biosciences, and veterinary sciences.

To use: Click in text field or area you would like to dictate in. Click the Speech-to-Text icon in the toolbar and then the mic icon to begin dictation.












Google Docs Audio Notes

Leave audio notes within any Google Doc. Great way to efficiently notate your documents or to leave remarks on documents that are shared with others.


To use: Be sure you are in a Google Doc. Highlight the text that you would like to leave an audio note for and click on the Audio Note icon in the toolbar. Click on the mic icon to begin recording as well as stop recording. When finished, click on Add Audio Note.



Zoomed Reading Ruler

Tool to allow focused reading comprehension for individuals wanting to limit the amount of material being presented.

To use: Click the Zoom Ruler icon in the toolbar and select the appropriate size.






Quick Search

A quick and easy way to open new Google searches based on keywords or phrases.

To use: Highlight any text and click on the Quick Search icon in the toolbar.



Translation

Get quick translations of terms or phrases in Spanish, French, or German.

To use: Highlight any text and click on the Translation icon in the toolbar.



OCR

Extract text from images, pdfs, or anywhere text is unavailable to highlight. The OCR tool is great for retrieving text to be used in notetaking and more.

To use: Click on the OCR icon if available. Click and hold to drag your selection over the text you would like to extract. Once the click is released, the OCR tool will extract and copy the text within your selection. A message will appear when the text is ready for pasting.



In summary, notetaking facilitates both recall of factual material and the synthesis and application of new knowledge, particularly when notes are reviewed prior to exams.
